will show at **SQUIRREL HAUS ARTS**, 3450 Snelling Avenue in Minneapolis from **November 18, 2017 – January 14, 2018.**

Most of the art is from the 1960s to the present: photography, posters, folk art, paintings, drawings, prints, small sculpture, ceramics and wearable art. Artists include many of Cuba's most popular and venerated, as well as young, new creators.

**OPENING NIGHT**, Saturday, November 18, from 3 to 11 pm, Squirrel Haus Arts will become a mini-version of Havana's famed *Fábrica de Arte Cubano* (Cuban Art Factory), with Cuban music, movies, snacks, & drinks, as well as the many forms of art in the exhibit. Regular gallery hours for the exhibit will be 12 – 5 pm, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Most living artists in the show work in Cuba today and artists all over the island will be represented in the show. Best of all, this art is for sale, you can take a piece of Cuba home with you!
